

BGA Uniform Policy

SY 23-24

Purpose

The purpose of BGA's Uniform Policy is to provide additional opportunities for increased school safety, to encourage our students to experience a greater sense of school identity and belonging, and to improve on student participation and behavior.

Uniform 6th & 7th

Students must wear a royal blue BGA top, which can be a t-shirt, polo, sweatshirt, zip-up, or hoodie.



Uniform 8th

Students must wear a black BGA top, which can be a t-shirt, polo, sweatshirt, zip-up, or hoodie.



Students can wear whichever pants, trousers, shorts, etc, that makes them comfortable, as long as it conforms with the dress code.

Uniform Violation Sheet

All Middle School students are required to wear uniforms. Students who are in violation of the policy will be subject to the following consequences:

- 1** First time without uniform, student will be given a loaner shirt and a phone call home.
- 2** Second time, student will be required to give collateral (phone, keys, airpods, etc) for a loaner shirt and a uniform policy sheet will be sent home to be signed by both the student and their parent/guardian.
- 3** Third time, student will be required to give collateral (phone, keys, airpods, etc) for a loaner shirt and a parent and student meeting will be scheduled.

Uniform 6th & 7th

Third time, student will be required to give collateral (phone, keys, airpods, etc) for a loaner shirt and a parent and student meeting will be scheduled.
